

Nyepi is a Balinese a day of silence, fasting and meditation for the Balinese that is commemorated every Isakawarsa (Saka new year) according to the Balinese calendar. Observed from 6 a.m. until 6 a.m. the next morning, Nyepi is a day reserved for self-reflection, and as such, anything that might interfere with that purpose is restricted.

For tourists and travelers, it is the perfect time to experience Bali. A few days prior, the Melasti Ritual is performed, dedicated to Sanghyang Widhi Wasa and is conducted Balinese temples near the sea and meant to purify Arca, Pratima, and Pralingga (sacred objects) belonging to several temples, also to acquire sacred water from the sea. It's beautiful and alluring to witness parade of Balinese people performing the rituals.

A day prior to Nyepi, around sunset the "Pengrupukan" ceremony begins in the house compounds with the noisy banging of pots and pans and bamboo tubes along with burning of dried coconut leaf torches to drive out the demons. Most Hindu Balinese villages make Ogoh-ogoh, demonic statues symbolising negative elements or malevolent spirits or even characters from Hindu mythology, and parade these during Pengrupukan day.

Then comes the silence day where no lighting fires (and lights must be kept low); no working; no entertainment or pleasure; no traveling; and, for some, no talking or eating at all. Exception is being made to hospitality and emergencies (hotels and hospitals with noise and lights are kept at minimal). Night time during Nyepi is the perfect time to stargaze as the sky will be super clear from pollution.
